SHOW RULES

Show Rules. Work exhibited in Christkindl Market must be tasteful and in keeping with a family-oriented atmosphere. All displays will be inspected on Friday morning prior to the official opening and at intervals throughout the show to ensure that exhibitors comply with show rules. It is the exclusive right and responsibility of the show committee to interpret show rules and to require an artist to remove any work not in compliance with these rules. Should violations be repeated, the artist will be asked to remove his or her exhibit(s) from the show and will forfeit eligibility for participation in future Christkindl Markets.

Slides/Discs. Application slides must be of good quality and be an accurate representation of the size, style and quality of all work to be exhibited. (Images of an artist's work may also be submitted on a disc compatible with use on a laptop computer.) Applicants not conforming to this rule will be ineligible to show. Photographs of work will not be accepted. A slide of your booth is mandatory. Slides or discs belonging to those selected to show will be returned with their exhibitors' kit. Slides and refunded fees will be mailed to those not selected to exhibit in their return envelope. Please limit content to (3) close-up images of artist's work and (1) image of current display booth.

Commitment to Show. A signed application is a commitment to show. No refunds will be made for cancellation, or, removal for cause. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the show may be terminated at the discretion of the Chairman. Should the show be cancelled, booth fees will be returned.

Agents. Dealers or agents may not stand in proxy for artists they represent.

Sales Tax. All exhibitors must have a current New York State sales tax number and must display their sales tax certificate during the show. Sales tax in our city is 7.125 percent.

Interpretation of the Rules. Christkindl Market at the Granger Homestead reserves the right to make final interpretations of the rules. The jury consists of Finger Lakes area art professionals, highly experienced in each of the categories. Jurying is anonymous. Artist selection is made solely on the basis of

work as seen in the slides. Work is scored on a numerical basis; artists with the highest score in each category will be accepted. Therefore, the image quality of the slides or discs is very important. Decisions of the jurors are final.

Waitlist Procedures. Through the scoring process of the jury, waitlisted artists will be selected. Those artists will be the next 10% of high scores. They will be selected and notified, by category, of the available space.


DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

Booth Spaces. Booth spaces are approximately 10 feet wide by 10 feet deep. All exhibitors are expected to bring their own display units, materials, tables, chairs, panels, plastic covering material for overnight, etc. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping booth(s) clean and orderly during and after the show.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Read and follow the instructions carefully. Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be accepted.

Slides. Submit four slides or discs with each application: three (3) close-ups of your work, and one (1) of your booth as it will look on show day. Write your name and telephone number on the reverse side of each slide. Number the slides in the upper right hand corner (1,2,3,4) in the order you wish them viewed.

Slides must be 2" by 2" (35 mm) and must fit a carousel 80 tray.
